WHITE

Los Romeros Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile - this is a great Sauvignon Blanc which compliments both fish and meats and offers excellent value for money. It has aromas of herbs, grass, yellow plum, green pepper and a zippy lemon acidity

De Canal Pinot Grigio - Italy - So popular due to its amazingly easy drinking nature, typified by pear drop and delicate almond flavours.

Chablis, Paul Deloux - Burgundy, France - Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.

Carr Taylor "Alexis" Dry White - England - Don't under estimate this little English number. Produced from the glorious East Sussex countryside just outside Hastings. This wine is made from a Sauvignon Blanc clone and has fantastic zesty aromas, floral touches and a beautiful dry finish.

ROSE

Whispering Hills White Zinfandel, California - A beautiful salmon pink coloured wine, with loads of fresh summer fruit flavours and lively acidity. Made using California's own grape.

Pinot Grigio Rosé, Corte Vigna - Pavia, Italy - Off-dry, light and fresh with attractive fruit flavours of strawberry and Morel cherry delicate pink hue. Serve with grilled chicken, charcuterie or pasta with light sauces.

Los Romeros Merlot, Central Valley, Chile - This wine is soft, juicy and shows spiced plum and dark berry fruit; it has a velvety outlook and is quite light-bodied.

Dudley Stone Shiraz - South Africa - Delicious ripe berry fruits, soft tannins and notes of mint and herbs, with a silky finish.

'Explorer' Pinot Noir - Chile - Brilliant value pinot noir from one of Chile's top producers: ripe red fruits, with well-integrated tannins and vegetal hints for which this grape is famed.

Rioja, Marqués de Morano - Rioja, Spain - A lighter style of fruity Rioja with just a hint of the traditional oakiness, made for early drinking from the classic Tempranillo grape.
